

HISTORY OF ST. MARYS CHURCH

- AS THE COAL INDUSTRY BEGAN TO BOOM IN THE BLACKLICK VALLEY AREA, COAL BARONS HIRED EUROPEAN IMMIGRANTS TO WORK IN THE MINES. THESE PEOPLE BROUGHT THEIR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS WITH THEM TO AMERICA.
- AS A RESULT, NANTY GLO AND ITS SURROUNDING AREA WAS KNOWN AS A "MISSION FIELD" BY THE CATHOLIC CHURCH.
- A MISSION CHURCH WAS FORMED IN 1902 IN NANTY GLO AS AN OFF-SHOOT OF IMMACULATE CONCEPTION PARISH IN VINTONDALE, WHICH HAD BEEN ESTABLISHED A FEW YEARS EARLIER.
- > ST. CHARLES CHURCH IN TWIN ROCKS WAS BUILT IN 1917, AGAIN AS AN OFF-SHOOT OF IMMACULATE CONCEPTION PARISH IN VINTONDALE.

IN THE BEGINNING.....


WAS CONSTRUCTED IN 1903 IN NANTY GLO AT THE SITE OF THE PRESENT DAY SCHOOL BUILDING. THE CHURCH FACED NORTH, ON ROBERTS STREET.

INITIAL CONSTRUCTION



PROPERTY WAS PURCHASED ACROSS FROM THE ORIGINAL CHURCH ON CAROLINE ST, AND A BRICK CHURCH WAS BUILT THERE IN 1915. THE FRONT OF THE CHURCH FACED EAST ON CAROLINE ST, AS IT IS TODAY.


PROGRESS!!!!!

- THE INITIAL CONSTRUCTION DESIGN REMAINED THE SAME FROM 1915 UNTIL 1955.
- WAR II POPULATION IN NANTY GLO AND THE SURROUNDING AREA GREW TREMENDOUSLY; SO DID THE NEED FOR MORE WORSHIP SPACE. PLANS WERE MADE TO ENLARGE THE CHURCH BUILDING.
- ST JOHN VIANNEY PARISH IN MUNDYS CORNER WAS SPUN OFF OF ST MARYS PARISH DURING THIS TIME.

- MORE ROOM WAS PROVIDED TO THE LEFT OF THE ALTAR.
- ALSO, A SECOND CHOIR LOFT WAS CONSTRUCTED ABOVE THE NEW WORSHIP SPACE.

ST MARYS IS RENOVATED.....

- IN 1984, SOME STRUCTURAL DAMAGE WAS DISCOVERED IN THE CHURCH BUILDING.
- THE BUILDING COULD NOT BE USED;
 CONSEQUENTLY, MASS WAS HELD AT THE
 NANTY GLO FIRE HALL UNTIL THE CHURCH
 COULD BE REBUILT.

STRUCTURAL PROBLEMS: 1984

- ST MARYS PARISH FAMILY CELEBRATED THEIR FIRST LITURGY ON EASTER SUNDAY, 1987 IN THEIR NEW STRUCTURE.
- MOST OF THE INTERIOR WAS SALVAGED FROM THE OLD BUILDING. THE PEWS, ALTAR, AND WINDOWS WERE FROM THE 1915 ORIGINAL BRICK CHURCH. BOTH CHOIR LOFTS WERE NOT DISTURBED IN THE CHURCH REBUILD.
- THE CEILING LIGHTS WERE RETAINED FROM THE 1955 RENOVATION.

- ST. MARYS PARISH WAS DIFFERENT FROM MOST CATHOLIC PARISHES IN OUR AREA.
- MOST OF THE SURROUNDING TOWNS HAD CATHOLIC PARISHES MADE UP OF ETHNIC COMMUNITIES (ITALIAN, SLOVAK, IRISH, CROATIAN, POLISH, ETC.)
- BARNESBORO, PORTAGE, AND JOHNSTOWN ARE EXAMPLES OF MANY DIFFERENT CATHOLIC ETHNIC PARISHES IN ONE TOWN!


- THE STAINED GLASS WINDOWS AT ST MARYS TELL TWO DIFFERENT STORIES!
- MARYS STORY; THE STORY OF HER LIFE ON THE RIGHT AS YOU ENTER THE CHURCH, AND HER APPARATIONS THROUGHOUT THE AGES ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE CHURCH.

WINDOW DESIGN TELLS THE STORY....

- THE UPPER PART OF EACH WINDOW TELLS US A DIFFERENT STORY.... THE UPPER PART PORTRAYS THE IMAGE OF A SAINT. ALL THE SAINTS IN THE WINDOWS ARE OF DIFFERENT ETHNIC ORIGIN!!!
- OUR PARISH FATHERS APPARENTLY RETAINED THEIR ETHNIC ORIGIN WITH THE UPPER PART OF EACH WINDOW. SEPARATE, BUT TOGETHER AS ONE WORSHIPPING COMMUNITY!!!




