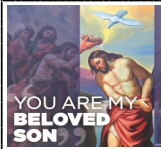

BAPTISM Call the Rectory to make arrangements for Pre-Baptism Classes early in your pregnancy (if this is your first child) and to arrange for the Baptism after your child is born. You must also be a registered and active member of the parish.

MARRIAGE In accordance with Diocesan directives arrangements must be made at least 9 months before the marriage date. All couples are required to attend Diocesan sponsored Pre-Cana sessions and to participate in the FOCCUS inventory. Call the rectory for information and schedules.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP We are always happy to welcome new parishioners. You may register any day, Monday through Friday, at the parish office. Registration, the practice of stewardship, and regular participation in the Eucharist indicates active membership and eligibility to act as a Godparent or Sponsor. Your stewardship of time, treasure, and talent is essential for the common good.

SAFETY IN THE PLACE OF WORSHIP DID YOU KNOW?

Having a safety plan... matters. In the time of an emergency, incident, or medical crisis, having a plan and people to execute that plan helps keep everyone safe. We must Plan, Prepare, and Protect. Saint Mary's Church has partnered with The Fatula Group for safety and security development and implementation. Since our partnership, we have developed an Emergency Operations Team (EOT). This team will discuss safety and security topics and develop policies, procedures, protocols, and practices that help keep us as safe as possible.

January 11 Stewardship Reflection The Baptism of the Lord

Jesus's baptism is a story we've heard before, so it is easy to lose sight of just how incredible it is - that Jesus wished to be baptized in the Jordan River by His cousin, John. We just spent the last two weeks marveling at the fact that this Savior of ours was born as a baby in a crude stable for our sake, and now this! Stop and contemplate our Lord, in all His perfection, waiting quietly and patiently in line with a bunch of sinners (like us) in order to "lead by example." His love and humility in serving and self-giving are beyond all telling.

And just in case there was any doubt about the extraordinary actions of Jesus that day at the Jordan River, we learn of the powerful affirmation of the Father. Who, immediately after the baptism, opens the heavens and sends the Holy Spirit upon Jesus in bodily form and says audibly. This My beloved son with whom I am well pleased!" Wow!

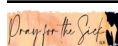

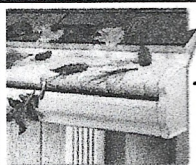

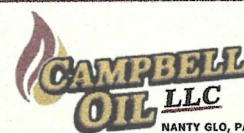
