BAPTISM Call the Rectory to make arrangements for Pre-Baptism Classes early in your pregnancy (if this is your first child) and to arrange for the Baptism after your child is born. You must also be a registered and active member of the parish.

MARRIAGE In accordance with Diocesan directives arrangements must be made at least 9 months before the marriage date. All couples are required to attend Diocesan sponsored Pre-Cana sessions and to participate in the FOCCUS inventory. Call the rectory for information and schedules.

THE 125th ANNIVERSARY OF THE DIOCESE OF ALTOONA-JOHNSTOWN All the faithful are invited to a Mass of Thanksgiving celebrated by Bishop Mark today, at 2:00 PM at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Altoona. Priests, deacons, and men and women religious will be in attendance. All parishioners of the diocese are welcome and encouraged to attend the Mass.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK will be offered after the 10:30 AM Mass, June 7. Those who wish to be anointed should come to the front of the church. Vatican Council said that the Sacrament of the Sick is not only for those who are in danger of death, but for the faithful suffering from serious illness, great pain, afflictions of old age, and serious mental illness. This sacrament strengthens the soul of the sick person, arouses confidence in Divine Mercy, helps to bear the trials of sickness, and sometimes brings healing to the body.

MAY 31 STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that the Holy Trinity is the 'central mystery of the Christian faith' (261). The concept of the Triune God - Three Persons in one God - is truly a mystery, almost too lofty for us ordinary people to even begin to grasp. Can the truth of the Holy Trinity teach us anything as everyday Christian stewards? Of course it can!

St. John Paul II described the Holy Trinity as a 'Divine Family', a community of Persons Who give themselves completely to each other and Who wishes to share itself, its life, with us. These concepts are at the very heart of the stewardship way of life. As stewards, we too are called to share ourselves and our lives with others. As a stewardship parish, we are called to invite others into our community through the gift of hospitality.

Amazingly, the more we give of ourselves to God in love, the more we will find the 'grace of the Lord, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit within us.' The God of the universe - this mysterious, Triune God - invites us to an ever-deepening intimacy with Him when we make our lives a loving gift to Him and to others through the stewardship way of life.

OBEDIENCE

Disobedience was humanity's original sin. Conversely, obedience became the instrument of humanity's reconciliation to God.

Scripture calls man's submission of his own intellect and will to God, the author of revelation, "the obedience of faith." (CCC143) "To obey in faith is to submit freely to the word that has been heard, because its truth is guaranteed by God, who is Truth itself," we read in the Catechism (CCC 144).

We see perfect obedience shown by Christ amidst his agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. His human will dreads what will come. "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me," but his divine will, which is never at odds with his human will, submits to the Truth: "Yet, not as I will, but as you will." (Matthew 26:39). Despite his fear, he embraces the divine will for man to be redeemed, and so we say that he was "obedient unto death. (Philippians 2:8)

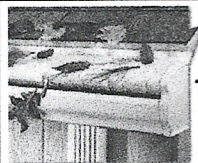
