Mini Explanation

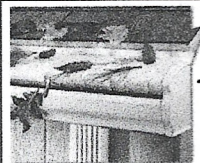

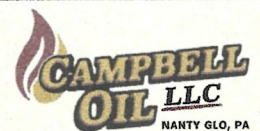
