## JUNE 28 STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

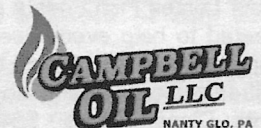
