BAPTISM Call the Rectory to make arrangements for Pre-Baptism Classes early in your pregnancy (if this is your first child) and to arrange for the Baptism after your child is born. You must also be a registered and active member of the parish.

MARRIAGE In accordance with Diocesan directives arrangements must be made at least 9 months before the marriage date. All couples are required to attend Diocesan sponsored Pre-Cana sessions and to participate in the FOCCUS inventory. Call the rectory for information and schedules.

1. **FAST** - Do not eat any food an hour before the Mass. Only water is allowed.
2. **COME EARLY** - Allow 10 - 15 minutes of meditation before the Mass.
3. **DO NOT EAT** - Eating is not allowed during Mass.
4. **DRESS PROPERLY** - This is to show decency and honor to God
5. **NO PHONES** - Turn your mobile phones off.
6. **GENUFLECT** - Kneel your right knee in the direction of the tabernacle before sitting.
7. **PARTICIPATE** - Sing, respond, listen, and pray.
8. **COMMUNE** - Examine conscience beforehand.
9. **THINK OF OTHERS** - Respect the pew and queue.
10. **BE STILL** - Don't be in a hurry. Enjoy and feel God's presence and thank Him for His graces.

JULY 19, 2026 STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings are filled with lessons both cautionary and consoling for the Christian steward.

Our first reading, from the book of Wisdom, reminds us that our God is just as well as kind, all-powerful as well as merciful. "For You show Your might when the perfection of Your power is disbelieved... But though You are master of might, You judge with clemency." God is indeed kind and loving, but He is also a just judge and the day will come when we will have to give an account for what we have done with the gifts of time, talent and treasure that He entrusted to us during our lifetime. We will be judged by God for the part we played - or did not play - in the building of His kingdom.

We are never alone in this work, however, as we are reminded in our second reading from the letter to the Romans. "The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness... the Spirit himself intercedes with inexpressible groaning." We must turn to the Holy Spirit continuously to guide us in our daily lives as Christian stewards. The Holy Spirit is the source of all wisdom. He will reveal to each of us the unique mission the Father has given us, as individuals and as a parish family, in the building of the kingdom of heaven. And He will give us the strength we need to remain faithful to our mission.

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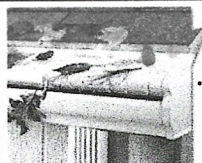
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
