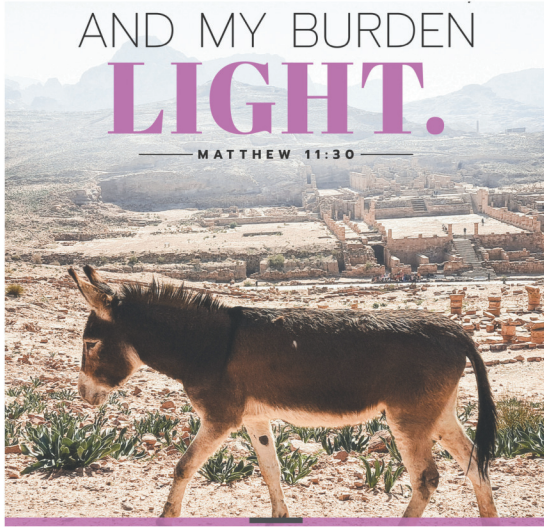
BAPTISM Call the Rectory to make arrangements for Pre-Baptism Classes early in your pregnancy (if this is your first child) and to arrange for the Baptism after your child is born. You must also be a registered and active member of the parish.

MARRIAGE In accordance with Diocesan directives arrangements must be made at least 9 months before the marriage date. All couples are required to attend Diocesan sponsored Pre-Cana sessions and to participate in the FOCCUS inventory. Call the rectory for information and schedules.

PARISH MEMBERSHIP We are always happy to welcome new parishioners. You may register any day, Monday through Friday, at the parish office. Registration, the practice of stewardship, and regular participation in the Eucharist indicates active membership and eligibility to act as a Godparent or Sponsor. Your stewardship of time, treasure, and talent is essential for the common good.

In January of this year, Pope Leo XIV, established a special Jubilee Year in commemoration of the Eighth Centenary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi. Through Decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary, a plenary indulgence has been granted under the usual conditions to those who participate devoutly in this extraordinary Jubilee.

Conditions for Plenary Indulgence

- Visitation in the form of a pilgrimage of any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world, where one renews one's profession of faith, through the recitation of the Creed, to reaffirm one's Christian identity.
- Sacramental confession (in the eight days before or after the pilgrimage.)
- Participation in Mass and Eucharistic Communion.
- Recitation of the Lord's Prayer, to reaffirm the dignity of the children of God, received in Baptism.
- Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father, the visible sign of the Church's unity.

JULY 5, 2026 STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The theme of humility is central to our readings today. God Himself is a humble God, so if we wish to follow Him as Christian stewards, we too must be humble. In fact, humility is key to the stewardship way of life, and to a peaceful and fulfilling life.

Our first reading from Zechariah foretells the unexpected way in which the Lord, the Savior of the world, will arrive. "See, your king shall come to you, a just savior is he, meek and riding on an ass... and he shall proclaim peace to the nations." It is almost unfathomable that our almighty and all-powerful God would humble Himself to live among us as one of our own, let alone to contemplate the unassuming way in which He arrived - born as a helpless baby, growing up under the care of human parents and finally making his entrance as savior on a lowly colt.
